PROFESSOR ARTHURS PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO GO THROUGH ALL THESE CONCERNS OF INJURED WORKERS HAVE TO GO THROUGH BY NEVER WORKING AGAIN, THE GOVERNMENT IS TAKEN US FOR GRANTED, WE ARE CANADIAN AND SHOULD BE TREATED WITH DIGNITY AND RESPECT. I WAS A HARD WORKING INDIVIDUAL WILLING AND ABLE AT ALL TIMES, NEVER LETTING ANYTHING STOPPING ME FROM DOING MY WORK, UNTIL I GOT INJURED. I HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO TAKE CARE OF MY FAMILY. WE ARE LIVING IN POVERTY AND THIS HAS TO STOP. CANADIANS MUST BE TREATED BETTER THAN THIS (2.5% PERCENT DOES NOT CUT IT. THE GOVERNMENT NEEDS TO WAKE UP AND SEE WHAT INJURED WORKERS GO THROUGH. THANK YOU FOR TAKING THE TIME TO LISTEN TO OUR CONCERNS AND I HOPE YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE FOR ALL INJURED WORKERS.
